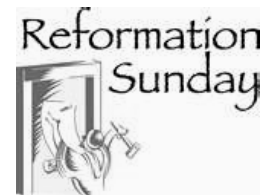
SMART board Fund- has started to grow. The fund contains \$600 dollars. Every dollar counts. If you would like to donate please contact the offices.
