**The Passion of Our Lord
According to St. Luke - Part 3: Luke 22:54-71**

Evangelist: *Then they seized him and led him away, bringing him into the high priest's house, and Peter was following at a distance. Then a servant girl, seeing him as he sat in the light and looking closely at him, said,*
